

**ORDINANCE NO. 2210-18**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 25 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, ARTICLE II, POLICE DEPARTMENT, SECTION 25-12, CONTRACTED OFF-DUTY EMPLOYMENT, SUBSECTION D, RATES OF COMPENSATION, ADMINISTRATIVE FEE AND PAYMENT FOR SERVICES, SO AS TO MODIFY THE RATES THEREUNDER FOR OFF-DUTY SERVICES IN THE HAWTHORNE PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Hawthorne, in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1. Chapter 25, Department of Public Safety, Article II, Police Department, Section 25-12, Contracted Off-Duty Employment, Subsection D, Rates of Compensation, Administrative Fee, Payment for Services, is hereby amended so as to create Subsection D (4), setting the rate of compensation for off-duty law enforcement in public schools, the same to read as follows:

D. Rates of Compensation, Administrative Fee, Payment for Services

(4) Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, it is agreed that the rate of compensation to be paid by the Hawthorne Board of Education utilizing the services of an off-duty law enforcement officer in Hawthorne Public Schools shall be at a rate of \$25 per hour. The rate may be amended from time to time by resolution duly adopted by the Municipal Council. The administrative cost and vehicle use cost set forth elsewhere herein shall not apply to such contracted work.

Section 2. If any section, subsection or part of this ordinance is adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final adoption and publication as provided by law.
