

ORDINANCE NO. 2110-14

AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE TO AMEND, REVISE AND REPLACE CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 220, FEES, AS WELL AS RELATED SECTIONS OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE, SO AS TO AMEND RATES AND FEES FOR FIRE PREVENTION BUREAU, BOARD OF HEALTH, LIMOUSINE LICENSES, DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS AND NONRESIDENT COMMUTER PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Hawthorne, in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1. Chapter 220, FEES, of the Code of the Borough of Hawthorne, shall be and hereby is revised, amended and supplemented by modification of the various fees provided therein so that the same shall read as follows:

220-1 SCHEDULE OF FEES

The following schedule of fees is hereby established with respect to licenses, permits and activities required or regulated under the provisions of various chapters of the code of the Borough of Hawthorne. Applications for and the issuance of such licenses and permits shall be subject to the provisions of the specific chapter of the Code that is indicated for each type of license or permit. The business, activity or operation for which the license or permit is required shall be subject to all regulations set forth in the chapter to which reference is made:

Chapter of Code

Section 220-2. Ch 25, Department of Public Safety, Article IV, Fire Prevention Bureau

Permits Under the Uniform Fire Safety Act and Uniform Fire Code Fee

For inspections required under the Uniform Fire Safety Act, Uniform Fire Safety Code or regulations of the Department of Community Affairs, for which no fee is provided in the Act, Code or applicable regulation, there shall be charged the following annual fees, which shall be payable not later than 30 days after notification of the respective occupant of the assessment of such fee

Occupancies up to 499 square feet	\$40
Occupancies 500 to 999 square feet	\$55
Occupancies 1000 to 2,999 square feet	\$70
Occupancies 3,000 to 4,999 square feet	\$85
Occupancies 5,000 to 6,999 square feet	\$100
Occupancies 7,000 to 8,999 square feet	\$115
Occupancies 9,000 to 10,999 square feet	\$130
Occupancies 11,000 square feet and over	\$150

Multiple-family dwelling inspections. Fees for inspection of common areas of dwellings consisting of three or more units based on number of common areas for one property (Use group R-2)

Up to 3 common areas	\$50
4 to 10 common areas	\$65
11 to 20 common areas	\$125
21 to 50 common areas	\$175
51 or more common areas	\$225

Resale, per unit

For applications filed 5 or more days prior to requested inspection date	\$65

For applications filed less than 5 days prior to requested inspection date \$85

Section 220-13A. Ch. 425 Solid Waste

Fees for disposal of certain waste

A. In addition to any fees set forth in Chapter 425, Solid Waste, as the same may be further described in Chapter 376, Recycling, the following fees shall be payable for disposal of certain materials at the Recycling Center

(1) Construction Debris.	
Except as otherwise specified, residents bringing construction debris to the C & D Dumpster shall pay the following charges	
a. One car or pick-up truck	\$35
b. Additional disposal, same day	\$50
(2) Carpet and Rugs	
Residents bringing carpets or rugs to the C & D Dumpster shall pay the following charges	
a. For each carpet or rug no more than 5 feet in length and rolled to 12 inch diameter or less	\$5
b. For each carpet or rug not conforming to the above specifications	\$20

Section 220-18A. Ch. 505, Vehicles and Traffic. Article IV, Commuter Parking and Resident Restricted Parking Areas, Section 505-29, Nonresident commuter parking stickers.

A. Nonresident commuter parking sticker, full year	\$700
From and after July 1 st of each year	\$350

Section 2. Chapter 310, Limousines and Livery Service, Section 310-5, Fee, shall be amended and replaced and shall read as follows:

Chapter 310 Limousines and Livery Service

Section 310-5. Fee. The application shall be accompanied by a fee as set forth in Chapter 220, Fees.

Section 3. Chapter 425, Solid Waste, Section 425-6, Construction and Demolition Waste, shall be amended so as to add thereto section 425- 6(E), said section to read as follows:

Chapter 425 Solid Waste

Section 425-6. Construction and demolition waste

E. In addition to any fee or cost set forth in this section, the disposal of certain construction and demolition material at the Recycling Center of the Borough of Hawthorne by Borough residents may require the payment of fees as set forth in Chapter 220, Fees.

Section 4. Chapter 505, Vehicles and Traffic, Article IV, Commuter Parking and Resident Restricted Parking Areas, shall be amended at Section 505-31, Fees, so as to read as follows:

Section 505-31. Fees. The fees set forth hereunder may be amended by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Hawthorne from time to time, in its discretion, by resolution duly adopted or by ordinance, with such fees to be set for in Chapter 220 of the Code of the Borough of Hawthorne, Fees.

Section 5. All other parts or provisions of Chapters 220, 310 and 425 of the Code of the Borough of Hawthorne or any other ordinance or regulation not specifically amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final adoption and publication as provided by law except that the amended to Chapter 505, Vehicles and Traffic, increasing fees for nonresident commuter parking stickers, shall not take effect until July 1, 2014.
