Topics Addressed:

- **Summer Leadership Camp-** Captain R. McAuliffe discussed the Leadership Camp that will be held at LMS on August 16-20. The total enrollment as of this date is 120 6th grade students. He also explained that Mrs. Della Pesca will be soliciting sponsors for the breakfast and lunch that is provided to those in attendance. He also stated that two (2) teachers will be facilitating the program along with volunteer police officers. All are welcome to attend.
