Adequate notice of the meeting has been provided by the annual schedule of regular meetings, heretofore adopted and posted on the Public Bulletin Board at the Municipal Building, mailed to the Hawthorne Press and all persons who have requested the mailing of such schedule and copy of such schedule remained on file in the office of the Borough Clerk from December 15, 2009.

OLD BUSINESS

A motion to approve the minutes of the September meeting was made by Tom Saraffian and seconded by Frank Kabrel. All were in favor.

SMAC testing (Blood Screening) was held on September 29th with 49 residents attending. The cost was \$20 for the screening and over \$900 was charged for additional tests. The results were received in a week and sent to the residents.

On November 9th the Annual Flu Clinic was held in the courtroom. Approximately 146 attended, of which 20 were borough employees. Dr. Joseph Lozito's physician's assistant, Bob, helped with the immunizations.

NEW BUSINESS

A communication was received from the County of Passaic of a violation for Getty of Newark. The violation was for Underground Storage Tank: Found guilty of operating with faulty Storage II vapor recovery equipment. (97 Lafayette Ave.)

The New Jersey State Registrar, Joseph Komosinski, is retiring as of Dec. 1st and until a new one is appointed, Yamileth Contreras will be the acting director. The state safety paper with Joseph Komosinski's name printed on cannot be used after July 1.

A security alert was issued from Kentucky concerning missing safety paper.

Thanksgiving baskets are being made up with turkeys donated from the Lions Club and groceries from schools. We also received gift cards, turkeys, and food from many borough residents.

Plans are also being formulated, along with the borough police, for the coming Christmas holidays to help needy children.

There being no further business to come before the board, Lucy Pataki made a motion to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Viola Sweeney and all were in favor. The next meeting will be on Thursday, January 20th at 7:00pm.
