 - ii. Tree and Woodland Program – Cindy Frank will follow-up with Phil Savioe regarding the status – E-mail response from Phil – tree management plan is in place; however, the tree canopy goal has not been adopted by Hawthorne. Need to further discuss with Phil
 - iii. Mayor's Wellness Program – Assigned to Pat Hutzelman. Next Step: review the 4 parts – Youth in Motion, Employees in Motion, Seniors in Motion, and Communities in Motion and make a list of the existing Hawthorne programs that fit these categories. Develop a questionnaire for each of the existing programs to get a detail summary of each of the programs.
 - iv. Walking Paths in Hawthorne – The walkable assessment form has been developed for Hawthorne. The team reviewed the walkable assessment. Green team decided to utilize the "How walkable is your Community" from the Pedestrian and Bicycle Information Center walkability checklist instead of the one reviewed. Next Step: Cindy will develop an Excel spreadsheet of the walkable assessment.
