

**BOND ORDINANCE NO. 2139-15**

**A BOND ORDINANCE TO AMEND BOND ORDINANCE 2106-14, HERETOFORE ADOPTED BY THE BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE, PROVIDING FOR RECONSTRUCTION OR REPLACEMENT OF SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAY APRONS ON IDENTIFIED SITES ON MAY STREET, MOHAWK AVENUE, ETHEL AVENUE, MAZUR PLACE, MAITLAND AVENUE OLD ORCHARD DRIVE AND PEACH TREE COURT AS DESCRIBED SPECIFICALLY HEREIN, IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF HAWTHORNE IN THE COUNTY OF PASSAIC, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY THOUSAND (\$160,000) DOLLARS THEREFOR, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OR NOTES FOR FINANCING PART OF THE COST THEREOF AND DIRECTING SPECIAL ASSESSMENT OF THE COST THEREOF SO AS TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED THEREUNDER TO ONE HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN THOUSAND (\$167,000) DOLLARS AND INCREASING THE EXPENSE PERMITTED UNDER SECTION 40A:2-20 FROM THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$35,000) DOLLARS TO FORTY THOUSAND (\$40,000) DOLLARS.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Hawthorne, in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1. Bond ordinance 2106-14, heretofore adopted on March 19, 2014, shall be and hereby is amended so as to provide at Section 1 thereof and all other relevant Sections that the amount appropriated under said bond ordinance shall be increased from \$160,000 to \$167,000 and the amount of the down payment authorized and anticipated by the bond ordinance is increased from \$8,000 to \$8,350.

Section 2. Bond ordinance 2106-14 shall be further amended at Section 2 thereof so that the amount to be financed through the issuance of negotiable bonds or notes shall be increased from \$152,000 to \$158,650.

Section 3. Bond ordinance 2106-14 shall be further amended at Section 4 (d) so as to increase the maximum amount for items of expense under Section 40:2-20 shall be increased from \$35,000 to \$40,000.

Section 4. All other parts or provisions of Bond ordinance 2106-14, not specifically amended by this Bond ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final adoption and publication as provided by law.
