



Weather Safety Tips

Frigid weather leads to broken water lines in areas with reduced or improper heating. This is especially true in crawlspaces and exterior walls where heating may be ineffective in tempering severe cold.

Exterior water faucets should have water turned off on the interior to protect from freezing and bursting.

During bouts of excessive cold, heating units will work twice as hard to maintain building comfort; they must be kept clean and free from flammable objects. A qualified technician should inspect your heating system annually prior to the onset of winter if possible.

Space heaters should be of good working order and strictly adhered to as per the operating instructions, never leave units operating and unattended.

In all cases please be sure to have a properly functioning smoke and carbon monoxide detector.
