1. **Fall Planting Update** – Tree planting started on Wednesday, Oct. 18th. Maureen & Kevin to update with specific issues, some addresses were questionable about planting, some refusals by residents and some residents were very happy to get a tree. There's a couple of specific addresses to discuss.
2. **Post-Planting Meeting** – the HSHTC members and Downes to schedule a meeting in November to discuss the planting issues – there are 10 trees that still need to be planted in the next week.
3. **CEU Webinars & Core Training** – Jodi sending out Links to the Webinars (1 to 1.5 hrs.)
4. Update on **Open Removals / Prunings** and residential issues (Maureen & Kevin) – PO 23-01088/June removals complete (18 trees), PO 23-01253/July removals complete (13 trees), PO 23-01442/August Prunings (17) and PO 23-01259/July Prunings (33).
5. The **98th Annual NJ Shade Tree Federation Conference** in Cherry Hill - October 26th and 27th – update
6. AI had submitted the application & was granted by the **Passaic County City Green Program the 1,000 Daffodil bulbs** again this year. AI picked up the bulbs in Clifton for planting at the schools and the Municipal Building in November. HSHTC was also granted **5 Red Bud Tree Saplings** – they were planted at the Pool Complex.
