January 6, 2023

Hawthorne child care centers, public school system, and private school immunization audited reporting 100% compliance in 2022.

Communication with Chief of Police James Knepper daily to weekly covid-19 update statistics.

School nurses mandated to submit total # covid-positive/other illness of students/staff to NJ Department of Health weekly, every Wednesday which started 10/26/2021 and continued during year 2022.

2022: School nurses/daycares updated daily/weekly/monthly with recommended NJDOH covid guidelines due to the covid surge and CDC decreasing covid positive isolation to 5 days.

01/27/2022 DOH directed LHD to call/investigate covid positive clients all ages and continues into year 2023.

Continues at times of surge during 2022 DOH directed LHD to call/investigate covid positive clients only age >65 years and < 18 years of age due to too many positive cases in the state to manage.

Municipal building mask policy enforced 8/20/2021 to 2/?/2022 (mid-February).

3/29/2022 webinar: COVID-19 Outbreak Management in Post-Acute Care Settings: Updated Guidance and Best Practices for LHDs completed by public health nurse.

April 2022 Covid-19 contact tracer assigned to Hawthorne PHN: decreased to part-time assistance.

May 2022 School nurses/daycares updated with recommended DOH immunization requirements for persons from Ukraine and for the monkeypox virus.

June 2022 NJDOH reported monkeypox virus cases in state of NJ.

Participation with the June “National Safety Month.”

Monkeypox virus case opened 7/21/2022: tracking # I-2022-23921. Closed case as not positive.

The Hawthorne “Flu Clinic” was held outdoors 10/21/2022: participants 9 high dose vaccines, 7 quadrivalent vaccines. History of flu clinic participants: 2021: 31 participants (28 {2020}), (35 {2019}, 43 {2018}, 40 {2017}, 66 {2016}, 63 {2015}, 92 {2014}).

11/12/2022 Hawthorne employee updated “cyber-security training” completed (online course) by the public health nurse.

November 2022 Ebola Virus: 2 cases investigated: closed, not positive.

November 2022 varicella (chickenpox) Roosevelt Elementary School 1 case.

November 2022 influenza outbreak Lincoln School 11/18/2022: form # CDS 36 completed.
