

My sidewalk may be lifted by roots from a Shade Tree, and I need to repair it. What is the procedure?

Thank you for maintaining your property, for safety as well as atheistic reasons!

- 1. First, retain a bonded mason contractor, who will secure a permit with the Borough to open the sidewalk.
 - Contact the Building Department at 973-427-5555 X214 for the permits process.
 - Take a moment to think about any trees that are located within 10 feet of the street curb. If a tree (wholly or partially) is located in this space, you MUST contact the Hawthorne Shade Tree Commission (see step 2)
- 2. The contractor or homeowner should contact the Shade Tree Commission to inspect any tree located within 10 feet of the curb and may be impacted by the sidewalk repair.
 - The HSTC Arborist can determine what course of action is needed <u>once the slab is lifted</u>.
 - Please be sure your construction site is clearly marked to avoid accidents!

 - No action should be taken with respect to the tree by the homeowner or the contractor. Any cutting without approval can result in a violation
- 3. The Certified Tree Specialist will come and review the tree and its roots to determine next steps.
 - Due to scheduling, the CTS may be there within a week to 10 business days
 - Work CANNOT proceed until the Arborist gives approval
 - Failure to obtain the Arborist approval may result in a fine and delays in your project as allowed by the Borough Shade Tree Ordinance, covered under Borough Ordinance Chapter 174
